

Who pays for hospice?

Medicare, Part A. Most people get Part A automatically when they turn age 65. They do not have to pay a premium because they or a spouse paid Medicare taxes while working. If you aren't eligible for premium-free Part A, you may be able to buy Part A. Part A covers 99% of hospice expenses leaving next to no out of pocket expenses for the patient. In addition, hospice is covered by most insurance plans. Many people don't realize this coverage includes the following:

- Physician consultations
- Nurse visits
- Medications
- Social Worker visits
- Medical equipment
- Other services not usually covered by Medicare (such as grief counseling)
